ORDINANCE NO.12

EXAMINATION AND OTHER FEES

(Refer Sections 7(viii), 3S(a) of the Act.)

(For the purpose of this Ordinance, the Act means Maharshi Panini Sanskrit Evam Vedic Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam 2006 (No. 15 of 2008))

1. All kinds of fees shall be deposited by a candidate through bank chalan only, in a bank approved by the University.
2. The bank chalan has to be filled by the candidate in four copies. The first copy is to be kept in the bank. The second copy is to be sent by the bank to the University along with a statement of total fees collected from time to time. The third copy is to be attached by the candidate with his application form. The fourth copy is to be retained by the candidate.

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4. The fees for each semester examination will be the same as that for annual examination.
5. If a candidate has to appear in a semester examination and has to appear simultaneously in one or two subjects of ATKT examinations of earlier semester examination(s), then he has to pay the fees of semester examination separately and each ATKT examination separately.
6. In addition to the-examination fees prescribed in clause 3 above, other fees shall also be payable along with the examination form follows :-

7. Each regular/private/ex/ATKT candidate has to pay to the examination centre, at the time of forwarding the examination form, a fee of Rs.75 for each examination in which he has to appear, as examination centre charges. From this fee the examination centre has to incur all the expenses for the conduct of the theory/practical examination including invigilation charges etc. and T.A/D.A to external examiners according to the rules of the University.

8. Each private candidate has to pay to the examination centre a fee of Rs. 40 for each examination in which he has to appear, as fees for forwarding the application form for the examination by the examination centre to the University. Out of this fees Rs 10 will be sent by the examination centre to the University and Rs. 30 will be distributed
9. A candidate appearing at the final examination has to pay a fee of Rs. 300 for his degree/diploma/certificate along with the examination application form for the ensuing examination. The degree/diploma/certificate will be sent to the examination centre, after he has passed the final examination, along with the marksheet. Ex-students appearing at the final examination need not pay this fees, unless they have not paid it earlier. The degree/diploma/certificate shall be in Sanskrit along with
